Annie Lee Holland Hisaw, 83, passed from this life on July 16, 2025 at Sanctuary Hospice House in Tupelo, MS. She was born in Prentiss County on June 1st, 1942, to Willie Nelson Holland and Ollie Bell Morgan Holland. She and her late husband, Raymond Earl Hisaw, served together in the ministry, evangelizing and pastoring for their 53 years of marriage before his passing in 2017. Growing up, she attended Burton, New Hope, and Holcut Schools and graduated from Coffee County High School in Douglas, Georgia. She worked as a school superintendent secretary before returning to Mississippi where she met the love of her life while working at Guntown Slacks. She continued to work as a seamstress at various local factories for a few years until transitioning into a stay-at-home mom continuing to use her sewing skills for friends and family. However, as her children grew older, she returned to public employment working with her sister, Carolyn, and brother-in-law Aaron in operating Carter's Fabric in both Burton and Corinth, MS locations. Eventually, she and her husband branched out by purchasing the Fabric Outlet in Tupelo, MS, where they worked together until their retirement in 2000. At the heart of everything she did was a very apparent love and devotion to serving Christ. While her most important ministry was first and foremost her family, she was also ready to serve in any capacity that was needed to support her husband's ministry at various congregations over the years. Her Christian impact will likely never be fully known in this life. However, Ann and her husband, leave for their family, a legacy of faithful Christian service to be carried on. Her

hobbies included sewing, gardening, canning and growing fruit, especially peaches.
